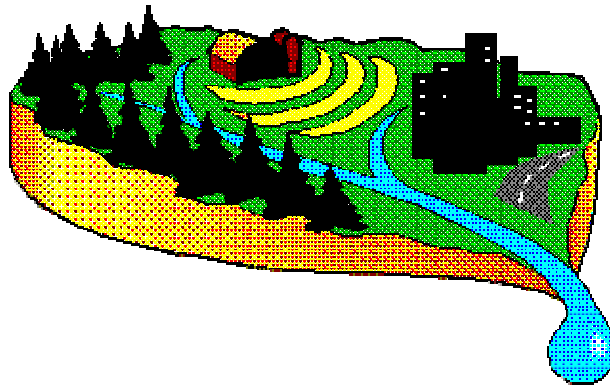


Summer Teacher Workshop at Two Mile Run County Park
